


# GALLO DANCE STUDIO 20/21 Recital Session

In response to the Covid-19 Phase 4 Re-Opening Procedures, we will be adhering to the following until further notice

## PREVENTIONS

All staff must comply with social distancing and hand-washing protocols, and will refrain from entering the building if they are experiencing any of the symptoms listed below.



The number of students & instructors allowed in the dance studio at one time will be restricted. Classes will consist of no more than 10 dancers. Dancers are expected to adhere to instructions provided with respect to social distancing.



All instructors & studio staff will be wearing masks during all classes. Dancers will be required to wear a mask to enter & exit their studios, and during some dance activities where social distancing of 6 ft can not be maintained.



Please keep your dancer home if they are feeling ill, or if they have been in contact with someone who is sick or tested positive for Covid-19. Please see the list of symptoms below.



Hand sanitizer is available in all studios. Bathrooms are stocked with hand soap for handwashing and hand sanitizer. Dancers must wash and sanitize hands after blowing their nose, sneezing, coughing or using restrooms.

## PROCEDURES

Our dressing room, front entry door, and lobby will not be in use during this session until further notice. Please have your dancer enter and exit their assigned studio from the studio exterior doors, rather than our main entrance. No parents or siblings are allowed into the dance studios, lobby, breezeway, or dressing room. ONLY Dancers, instructors and studio staff are allowed inside the studio.

Please have your dancer use the restroom before arriving at our studio. Each studio will have their own bathroom for use during class that will be cleaned in between each use.

Our water fountain & water filling station will not be available. Dancers are allowed to bring multiple water bottles, but will not be able to fill them from water sources within our facility.

Dancers will enter & exit Studio A or Studio B only through their exterior doors. Dancers will be directed to change into their dance shoes inside their specific studio, and they will remain inside their specific studio during the duration of their class. Please have dancer arrive no more than 5 minutes early for their class.

To maintain social distancing, please have them wait in your vehicle until our "DANCERS MAY BEGIN LINING UP FOR CLASS" sign is visible on their specific studio door. Have your dancer stand on a line on the sidewalk while waiting to enter the studio, the lines are spaced 6 ft apart. Please stand with your dancer if they are not old enough to wait on their own. **Please practice social distancing!**

We will let your dancer know when they can enter the studio and we will be admitting dancers one at a time.

We will do a quick forehead temperature check, and they will go to their designated chair to change their shoes.

Dancers will then be given hand sanitizer, and they will then proceed to their designated taped "box" on the studio floor to begin class.

Please make sure to be ready to pick up your dancer 5 minutes before their class is scheduled to end, our "CLASS DISMISSING" sign will be visible, and we will begin dismissing dancers one at a time. (This will allow us to sanitize surfaces in the studio before the next class begins.)

Please wait near your vehicle, or wait "socially distanced" from others outside, and watch for your dancer to come out.

We will wait until they are with you before dismissing our next dancer.

Out of consideration for all of our studio families, (we have several "high risk" dancers, and several "high risk" dance parents who are more vulnerable to severe illness and complications if they contracted the coronavirus), we respectfully request, that if your dancer has been traveling out of Illinois, or if they have been in large groups where they have not been social distancing, please have them:

- wear a mask during their dance class for the 2 weeks following their return from out-of-state or,
- wear a mask while they watch class for the 2 weeks following their return from out-of-state or,
- not attend dance class for the 2 weeks following their return from out-of-state.

Thank you for dancing with us this season, and thank you for following our safety procedures to help us provide a safe environment for our dancers in our studio.

## SYMPTOMS

Please do not allow your dancer to attend their class if they have any of the following symptoms:



headache, fever, runny nose, sore throat, dry cough, fatigue, chest pains, body aches, recent inability to taste or smell, shortness of breath, diarrhea, vomiting or abdominal pain
